Dear Friend,

We hope you are all enjoying your studies and stay in this country and those who have arrived recently must have settled down.

2. Some of you who have been here for a while, must have participated in programmes organized by ICCR for the benefit of foreign students. One of the most popular programmes has been the **Winter Camps (WC)**. ICCR has been organizing these Camps for past several years and students have been benefitted from such camps.

3. ICCR is proposing to organize WC in **December 2018- January 2019**. The itineraries of the camps for 6-7 days is under process which will be held in the state of Kerala or/and Karnataka. The details of the camp with dates will be announced shortly.

4. **Facilities and details of the Camps are as follows :**

(i) **Board & lodging** arrangements are made in hotels, huts, Guest House/Hostels etc. on share basis for 3 students in one room. Variety programmes, sight-seeing, debates etc. are organized all through the period. The programmes are educative and entertaining.

(ii) Selected candidates if not attending the camp under any circumstances Rs. 3,000/- will be deducted from his/her further scholarship dues. It is necessary to attach proof that scholar is studying under ICCR scholarship schemes. The scheme should be clearly mentioned in the application along with year she/he got admitted in the College/Institution/ University.

(iii) Application Form prescribed for participation in the camp could be downloaded from the ICCR's website (www.iccr.gov.in). The form will be uploaded shortly. Dully filled in application form should reach **The Programme Director (ISD-II), Indian Council for Cultural Relations, Azad Bhavan, Indraprastha Estate, New Delhi – 110002 by 10th December, 2018.** The form can also be submitted to respective Regional office of ICCR (for list of ICCR's regional office please visit ICCR's website).

5. Scheme is open only to ICCR Scholarship holding foreign students.

6. As the numbers of seats are limited, we would request you to enroll your names as early as possible to enable us plan the camps properly.

- 7. Family members of the scholars will not be allowed to join the camps.**
8. On completion of the camp all the students must submit the feedback form duly filled in to the respective Camp Officer and collect the participation certificate from him.
9. For any assistance please keep in touch with nearest regional office of ICCR of ICCR Headquarter in New Delhi.
- 10. Keeping in mind of the previous year experience, it is brought to the knowledge of all students to adhere to the instructions of ICCR and maintain strict discipline in the camps and abide by all the instructions given by the Camp Officer. Scholars should keep in mind that facilities provided will be restricted to those normally available to students (for e.g. hostel accommodation rather than hotel accommodation). In case students fail to follow the above instructions or misbehave or create any difficulty for the camp officers / organizers, ICCR reserve rights to take disciplinary action against them. If participant is creating any problem, Camp Officer is empowered to send his/her out from the camp on student's own risk.**
