## VISIT OF MS. RENÉ MERCEDES BAPTISTE, SPEAKER OF THE ORGANIZATION OF EASTERN CARIBBEAN STATES (OECS) PARLIAMENT AND FORMER CABINET MINISTER OF GOVERNMENT OF SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES, TO INDIA UNDER THE ICCR'S DISTINGUISHED VISITORS PROGRAMME (DVP)

Chandrachud, Minister of State for External Affairs and Culture, Smt. Meenakashi Lekhi.
