Dear Friends,

I hope you all are enjoying your stay and studies in India and those who have arrived recently, are settling down well.

- 2. As you may be aware, ICCR organizes programmes from time to time for the benefit of foreign students studying in India, including non-ICCR scholars. One of the most popular programmes has been the winter and summer camps. The Council has been organizing these Camps for past several years and students have actively participated in these. There are on a voluntary basis.
- 3. In **December 2021**, ICCR is planning to organize Winter Camps as per schedule given below:

Facilities and details of the Camps are as follows :

- (i) **Board & lodging** arrangements will be on sharing basis 2 in one room (men & women separate). Variety programmes, sight-seeing, debates etc. are organized all through the period.
- (ii) Fees: Camp Fee: Rs. 3,000/- per head. The Council will meet expenses on board, lodging, sight-seeing at various places etc. Once the selection letter is submitted no portion of the camp fee is refundable.
- (iii) Application: Application for admission to the camp is to be sent in the prescribed form which should reach to ICCR, Headquarter, New Delhi by 22nd November 2021 with the camp fee of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only). The camp fee may be sent through a crossed Bank Draft in favour of DIRECTOR GENERAL, ICCR, New Delhi. No Fresh Applications/request for Change of Camp will be entertained after 22nd November 2021.
- (iv) <u>Self-financing students</u> must submit a crossed Bank Draft of <u>Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand only)</u> drawn in favour of "Director General, ICCR", New Delhi, which is non-refundable.
- 5. First preference will be given to ICCR scholarship holders. Self Financing students' request will be considered if seats are available and if they give an undertaking that any expenditure on medical treatment/hospitalization etc. during the camps will be borne by themselves.
- 6. As the numbers of seats are limited, we would request you to enroll your names as early as possible to enable us plan the camps properly.
- 7. Family members of the scholars will not be allowed to join the camps.



- 8. On completion of the camp, all the students must submit the feed back form duly filled in the prescribed proforma to the respective Camp Officer and collect the participation certificate from them. The students must send their participation certificate alongwith request for refund of camp fee (entitled students) through the respective Regional Offices/ICCR, New Delhi with all the particulars like Name, Country, Scholarship Scheme, Name of Institution and File No.
- 9. Note: Keeping in mind the previous years experience, it is brought to the knowledge of all students that they will have to maintain strict discipline in the camps and abide by all the instructions given by the Camp Officer. The Council will be arranging suitable accommodation for all foreign participating students. In case students fail to follow the above instructions or found to be in violation of discipline or prescribed conduct, the Council will be constrained to take disciplinary action against them.
- 10. Extant and prevailing Covid-19 rules and regulations will have to be adhered by all.
