4. **Facilities and details of the Camps are as follows :**

(i) **Board & lodging** arrangements will be on sharing basis 2 in one room (men & women separate). Variety programmes, sight-seeing, debates etc. are organized all through the period.

(ii) **Fees:** Camp Fee: Rs. 3,000/- per head. The Council will meet expenses on board, lodging, sight-seeing at various places etc. **Once the selection letter is submitted no portion of the camp fee is refundable.**

(iii) **Application :** Application for admission to the camp is to be sent in the prescribed form which should reach to ICCR, Headquarter, New Delhi by **22<sup>nd</sup> November 2021** with the camp fee of **Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only)**. The camp fee may be sent through a crossed **Bank Draft** in favour of **DIRECTOR GENERAL, ICCR , New Delhi**. **No Fresh Applications/request for Change of Camp will be entertained after 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2021.**

(iv) **Self-financing students** must submit a crossed Bank Draft of **Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand only)** drawn in favour of "Director General, ICCR", New Delhi, which is non-refundable.

5. First preference will be given to ICCR scholarship holders. Self Financing students' request will be considered if seats are available and if they give an undertaking that any expenditure on medical treatment/hospitalization etc. during the camps will be borne by themselves.

6. As the numbers of seats are limited, we would request you to enroll your names as early as possible to enable us plan the camps properly.

7. **Family members of the scholars will not be allowed to join the camps.**
